1. Is SWE open to all engineering students?

Yes! SWE events are open to students of all majors and backgrounds. We invite everyone to attend who is an advocate for women in engineering and wants to support the outreach programs and internal activities we host.

2. Where do I go if I am struggling with work/managing school/etc?

All of us at SWE are here to help support you with balancing work, school, and life outside of TCU. We can be reached through GroupMe (the link to join is listed at the top of this document) at any time that you may need our help. If you are seeking additional help outside of SWE, we encourage you to set up a meeting with your counselor. While we know them best for helping with class scheduling, they also serve as a guidance mentor for any question you may have about how to be the most successful while facing tough challenges of being a college student. We also host events such as Study Nights, a Holiday Party, and Pi Day where our members are free to come to and hang out as long as they want! For our outreach program, we partner with an organization called Girls Inc. and one day each semester we spend time teaching young girls about STEM through fun activities (such as paper rockets and exploding ping pong balls). Overall the organization is very low stress but provides a great network of women engineers that you can talk to about anything!
