A Letter from Pixie: Losing a Member of Our Community

Hello Dear Fireflies,

On Burn Night we lost a beloved member of the community and came very close to losing two others.

Ian Denhardt from the Acolytes of Caffeina, and before that the F.U.C.C., Firefly since 2015, NECTR goer, newly bestowed the name Dropless, most loved spouse, Dear One, partner, metamour, best of friends, and all around excellent example of how to be a good human, is no longer with us. Words are inadequate to describe this loss.

Story Boyle from the Acolytes of Caffeina, and before that the F.U.C.C., Firefly since 2015, NECTR goer, Epic, spouse of Ian, cherished human, and font of creativity is still with us, and expected to make a full recovery, but it was entirely too close.

A close friend of Story and Ian's (who asked that his name not be shared) is also recovering at home. He is being cared for and is expected to make a full recovery.

At this point, Emily Teich (pixie) of the Universe, and before that F.U.C.C., is point of contact for all things to do with Ian or Story. She has created a discord server to give the community a place to connect and support each other while staying apprised of upcoming community catharsis events. The discord server is also where all well wishes, questions, thoughts, memories, offers of support, and other communiques of non-sensitive nature can be directed. If

there is a communicate containing sensitive information, it should still be directed specifically to Emily.

New Tickets Coming on Sale for Firefly Express Bus Rider Tickets!

We will be offering a **limited number of additional combined event + bus tickets (First Come, First Serve)**, which will go on sale Wednesday 6/28 at noon on the ticketing page, <https://volunteer.fireflyartscollective.org/>. These tickets will be available to anyone currently on the waitlist.

For a \$180 flat fee, you will be able to skip the waitlist to buy a combined event + bus ticket as long as supplies (bus seats) last - currently there are a few dozen. Important information to know:

- Buses leave from Boston area at noon on Tuesday 7/4 and Wednesday 7/5.
- Riders will be permitted one large suitcase, one carry-on size suitcase, and one day bag. Got more stuff? Read on and use the gear truck!

- Buses will make a 30-minute stop in White River Junction, for riders to buy groceries/perishables.
- **If you do not receive your wristband ON THE BUS you will not be permitted entry.** That is, if you buy this ticket you may not arrive at Firefly in any other way except the bus.

Note: this also means that if you are already ticketed for the event and plan to ride the bus, **buy your ticket before Wednesday** or they will sell out!

Leave No Trace: What it Means for You!

If this is your first Firefly, you will soon find out what a magical place these woods are and we want to work together to keep it that way through all our shenanigans. That is why regardless of volunteer shifts, everyone is on team LNT!

There is quite a bit of helpful info here, read it! Love it! Live it!

Everybody MOOPs!

It doesn't matter if you are a veteran or new-fly, theme or solo camper, MOOP is everyone's responsibility. MOOP is Matter Out Of Place, it happens to the best of us!

If you see a piece of MOOP, congratulations!

If you see it, pick it up: all day long you'll have good luck!

We don't do 'ground scores' at Firefly, bring lost personal items to the Lost and Found bin located at Upper Portos.

It's a great idea to check this bin daily, often we don't even realize what we've lost!

LNT pre-event:

Costuming:

Celebrate your style with shiny fabric, bold patterns and blinky stuff.

Leave the glitter, sequins and feathers at home.

Remove packaging / open new gear at home (or even in the store parking lot if need be)

Label your shit!

At the event:

Do daily MOOP sweeps, use a stick like a divining rod to push around leaves.

Waiting until the last day is sure to leave behind MOOP that has gotten buried.

Pee at least 50 feet away from the stream.

If you need to poop in the woods, poop in a bag and then ***take it home.***

Porto etiquette:

If it didn't come out of your body or is not 1 ply TP, it doesn't go in the potty!

No tampons, condoms, glow sticks, diapers, bags, headlamps, cellphones, hopes or dreams.

These clog the honey sucker and make a shitty job shittier!

Sit your butt on the seat OR lift the seat to hover.

Put the lid down when you are done for best ventilation.

After the event:

Line sweeps are the most effective and efficient - work together!

Stand arms length from your co-sweepers and walk in a line. Stay together in that line!

Look up!

See how beautiful this place is and offer thanks to the land for the honor to spend time here!.

Work Weekend #3 (June 23-25)

We had an even more successful and productive second Work Weekend (despite all the rain on Saturday), and are well positioned to be able to check off all the remaining things this upcoming *third* Work Weekend!

If you have not signed up yet, follow the link to the [Work Weekend Sign-up \(and Waiver\)](#).

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Larger theme camps may bring and begin to set up shade structures/infrastructure or to fly tarps over their area. Folks with large art projects who have already confirmed their placement may bring art up and stage it for assembly. ***Folks cannot leave behind any personal camping items at the end of the Work Weekend.*** Neither set up, nor under a tarp burrito - it all has to go back with you!
- Folks coming up to scout campsites - ****Look UP**** - notify work weekend coordinators if you see any widowmakers (broken branches) hanging over your campsite! We will do our best to bring them down safely, and if we can't we will put caution tape around the area.
- ***Do not terraform your campsite!*** You may use a rake to clear branches and sticks away from where you plan to place your tents/structures, but you can't turn your campsite into a construction project. If whatever you're planning requires shovels and mattocks, you're doing too much. Consider this your *CEASE & DESIST* notification. Bringing leaf blowers is strongly discouraged - if you blow all of the leaf litter away from paths and your campsite you would be leaving just dirt, which with a little bit of rain turns into slippery mud.
- ***Do not cut down any trees/saplings*** - even if they are in your way - anything that is growing vertically is to remain vertical. Anything that has already fallen down and is in your way can be cut down to smaller pieces and moved out of the way. Sharp dead branches on the pines that are hanging at head level or below may be trimmed to avoid accidents.
- ***Do not make new firepits*** - there are established firepits in certain areas. If a fire is started in any of the firepits, it must be monitored by at least one person at all times, and there must be a bucket of water nearby.
