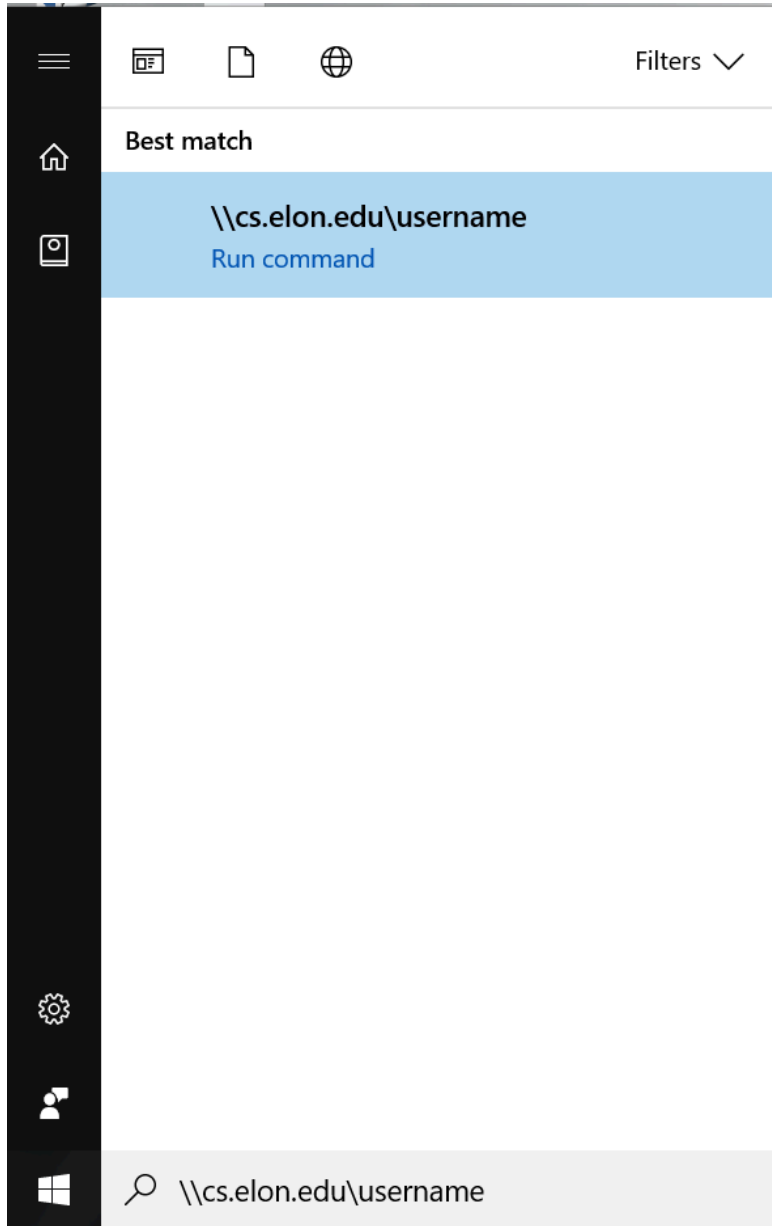


Instructions: Using cs.elon.edu on Windows 10

1. Check your network connection
 - a. If you are on campus, go straight step 2 below.
 - b. If you are off campus, ensure you are [running the VPN client](#) and connected to an on-campus network.
2. Click the start button and type `\\cs.elon.edu\username` (replacing my name with your Elon username). Then click *Run command* in the start menu.



3. You might not need this step. BUT...


If prompted, type `fs\dhutchings` (replacing my name with your Elon username) and your Elon email password
