

Balanced Math (Including CGI Cognitively Guided Instruction)

Balanced Math is a curricular structure used at EL schools Polaris Charter Academy in Chicago, WHEELS in New York, and several other non-EL charter networks in New York City. This structure involves five weekly components (likening it to a complementary program to "Balanced Literacy"), which ensure students consistently work with conceptual understanding, foundational math facts, and regular problem solving.

The five components are as follows:

- 1. Workshop (Using a guidance curricular tool like Eureka)
- 2. Problem Solving (CGI)
- 3. Routines / Jars
- 4. Fact Fluency
- 5. Intervention Block
