Discussion Items

1 Roll Call

2 Contest

More than 48 registered players now, will have 4 teams. Schedule is set but could use a field for 4/29 if any league has an assessable field available.

4 | Lineup cards – filling out the new card

A hand out was distributed that covers how to fill out the new lineup card designed to support CBO play (but can also be used for "bat 9" play).

Jason discussed the importance having all players listed on the lineup card.

There is a printable version available on the D54 website along with printing instructions for a printing company (e.g. Staples, Office Max) so that leagues may print for their use.

5 **Finalize Bylaws** – sections 10 and beyond

- League Rep + IRC
- Other polices and guidelines
- Interleague cheat sheet

Discussion was held regarding areas of the bylaws not previously approved.

Healthy conversation was held around time limits for interleague play and the proposed "Incident Review Committee".

Key decisions that came out of this discussion include:

Time limits

- Baseball: minors 1:45; Majors 2:00; 50/70 and above 2:15
- Softball: minors 1:45; Majors 2:00; Juniors and above 2:30

Incident Review Committee (IRC) Consensus reached:

- Trigger: An IRC would be formed at the request of a League President or District Staff Member
- Membership: The membership would always be an odd number – 3 or 5 – and one of these shall be the District Administrator
- Authority: A majority vote of the IRC would determine what recommendations or actions the DA will take
- Actions: At conclusion, the DA will advise the presidents of leagues involved of actions taken

The above were included in the revised by-laws.

Vote taken:

FNLL motioned to approve the By Laws with agreed changes made. Seconded by EDHLL.

Abstain: CRLL **No:** Snowline

Yes: All other leagues present

Then motion passed and the Bylaws were agreed to (final version accompanies these notes)

6 Tournament Recommendation

Erika presented a recommendation for solidifying the post-season tournament sites multiple years in advance (through 2025) with Woodcreek hosting most All Star tournaments (excluding Softball and

50/70) with TOC tournaments rotated as they are today. After a lengthy discussion the following items were agreed to:

- For 2023 go with the "Woodcreek plan" with Woodcreek hosting most All Stars except for Softball and 50/70; TOC would be assigned per our existing practice.
- Hosting requires volunteers which many find it difficult to get at tournament time. Agreement was reached that all teams in post season tournaments would travel with 2 volunteers which will be used for game-essential tasks (e.g. announcer, scorekeeper, pitch counter, etc.) as needed for the game for a total of 4 volunteers per game (2 home and 2 away). Volunteers need not be parents from teams but should represent the league the team is from.
- The recommendation for fixed multi-year tournament schedule was tabled and will be considered at another time (e.g. after the current season)
