Position Summary:

The Director of Services leads the development, implementation, and oversight of M.A.R.C.H. Inc.'s programs in Missouri, ensuring high-quality supervised visitation, mediation, and legal services. This position combines operational leadership with direct program oversight, including contractor supervision, service delivery monitoring, and strategic growth planning.

Key Responsibilities:

Program Leadership & Operations

- Oversee all Missouri-based programs, ensuring compliance with organizational policies and state regulations.
- Monitor program quality, including service delivery, reporting, and outcomes.
- Implement best practices and continuous improvement processes for service efficiency and effectiveness.

Staff Management & Development

- Supervise programs and contracted providers in Missouri.
