West Central Elementary School takes a proactive approach to discipline through our Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) program. We have adopted three behavior expectations which are taught to all students using the acronym RCS. We are Ready to Learn, Courteous, and Safe. At West Central, we will use the PBIS Rewards system to monitor positive behavior. Students who demonstrate positive behavior will be recognized in multiple ways including verbal praise, public recognition, PBIS Rewards points, and invitations to attend nine weeks celebrations.
