

DCAD liaison with other Dynamic Coalitions

DCAD is planning to increase liaison with other IGF Dynamic Coalitions (DC) to raise awareness about accessibility for persons with disabilities. This may be done through involvement in email or other online discussions by a DC, or to be part of a DC session at the IGF. Accessibility must be raised in the context of the particular DC as a value-add to the DC's activities.

A maximum of two DCAD members may nominate to join another DC for this purpose by including their name on the list below. Judith Hellerstein will offer any guidance to DCAD members about the process. A brief report (one to two paragraphs) is required by nominated DCAD members by the end of the calendar year. This will be amalgamated into the annual DCAD report for the IGF.
