**Discussion on a slight tangent: Senate presented plans for allocation of the \$50 mill donation and are soliciting feedback.**

**-\$3 mill seed fund. Concern: However, many groups already do this work, you don't need to create a whole new system/committee for research support.**

**-Draw attention to shared governance.**

**-CRSCA may want to draft a statement to communicate that we already have systems in place for on campus grant review.**

**-Statement of concern: "A transparent and inclusive proposal process is under development and will be shared widely with the campus community once completed." but we already do this.**

**-We might want to endorse a resolution stating that we would like to be involved in this process, would like to fulfill our role as stated in constitution and bylaws as it relates to CRSCA.**

**Minutes: Guest at meeting Director Christian Roessler to help answer questions.**

**-Office Space: It is the Director's faculty office, should they no longer be the director it will go back to being just a faculty office.**

**-Release rate issue was brought to Admin; it is not an issue because it's not a fee for service situation.**

**-Office space: one line clarifying issue: it's not that it's designated for the center, it's used for the faculty office and on the side as the center.**

**-Staffing: Center used to have staff, but no longer does; at that time Smith Center Director was supervisor of staff member. That is no longer true, as Director is not supervising the CBE office staff. Add a statement that the Charter does not obligate the university to contribute resources. Addendum to charter application on Interfolio. Suggested changes were made during meeting so it will not need to go through another round of review/revision, supported by Smith Director. Director confirms that in gift details there is no promise or obligation of office space or staff.**

**Motion to approve the Smith Center recharter application from Benjamin Smith, seconded by Jenny Hazlehurst. No objections, abstentions. Approved. Will be sent to ExCom for March 3rd meeting.**
