

KIDS AMERICA CODE OF CONDUCT

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Kids America is a family-friendly facility committed to providing a safe, respectful, and positive environment. Participation in leagues, tournaments and other activities is a privilege, not a right.

All players, coaches, and spectators must conduct themselves in a manner that reflects the integrity of the game and the standards of Kids America.

EXPECTATIONS

- Show sportsmanship, respect, and integrity at all times.
- Foul language, verbal abuse, taunting, or harassment toward officials, players, other teams or staff will not be tolerated.
- No alcohol, drugs, tobacco, or vaping are permitted in Kids America property.
- Anyone under the influence or impaired in any way will be removed immediately. Failure to comply will result in law enforcement involvement and possible suspension, forfeit or permanent removal.
- All players, coaches, and parents must follow Kids America's house rules and be mindful and respectful of Kids America members using other areas of the facility.
- Kids America employees have the final say.

RESPECT FOR OFFICIALS

- Officials' decisions are final. Only team captains/ Head coaches may respectfully address referees during a stoppage of play.
- Disrespect toward officials (verbal or physical) will result in immediate removal from the game or facility.
- Officials are essential for play — if you cannot respect them, this is not the place for you.

CONSEQUENCES FOR VIOLATIONS

- In case of Yellow Card violation: Arguing or unsportsmanlike behavior after a yellow card = Red card and immediate removal from the game.
- Red Card: The player must leave the facility immediately and will be suspended for the next game. The coach or team representative who registered the team will also be suspended for the next game.
- Aggressive Spectators: Any aggressive or inappropriate spectator behavior will result in one warning and then immediate removal for the day.
- Umpire/Official Disciplinary Actions: Officials may issue warnings, restrictions, ejections, or forfeits depending on the severity of misconduct. Persistent arguing, profanity, or abuse toward officials or players will result in removal and possible suspension. Continued or repeated violations may result in team suspension or permanent ban from Kids America programs.
- **There will be no refunds issued in the event of suspensions or bans.**

TOURNAMENT CONDUCT

- During tournaments, coaches are fully responsible for the behavior of their players, assistant coaches, and spectators.
- All teams must maintain the same standards of conduct expected during league play — including respect for staff, officials, opposing teams, and facility property.
- Any team-related misconduct (by players, coaches, or spectators) may result in immediate removal from the tournament, forfeiture of games, or exclusion from future events.
- All participants and guests are required to follow Kids America house rules and respect the facility and its members at all times.
- Kids America employees have the final say.
- **There will be no refunds issued in the event of suspensions or bans.**

FACILITY CONDUCT

- Respect facility property and staff at all times.
- No outside food or drink (water only on the turf).
- Teams are responsible for their spectators and any damage caused.
