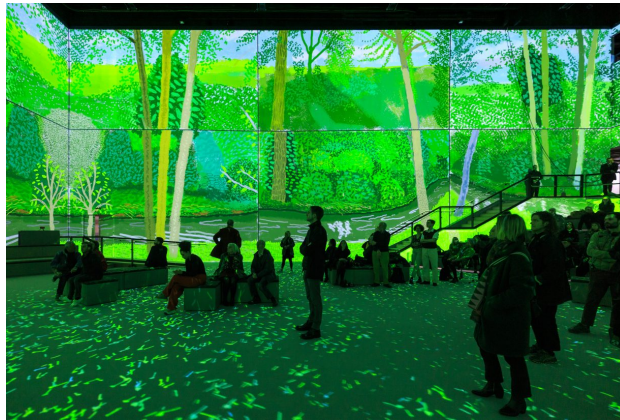




David Hockney Lightroom Exhibition

All of Year 3 are going to visit David Hockney's Lightroom Exhibition. We will be out of school for the day, so there will not be normal lessons. **That is ok.**



We will:

- wear our school uniform for the trip
