

### **VSLA VICTORIA OAKLEY LITERACY GRANT**

## **Description/Overview:**

This grant is in memory of Victoria Oakley, President of the Virginia State Literacy Association (2008-2009). Victoria's extensive career encompassed numerous roles, including that of reading teacher, elementary school principal, Director of Instruction, and Assistant Superintendent for Richmond Public Schools. Victoria Oakley had a particular passion for supporting students with dyslexia. She leaves a legacy of advocacy and dedication.

## **Eligibility:**

The Victoria Oakley Literacy Grant(s) will be offered annually for up to \$2,000 to a member of VSLA in good standing who seeks professional development/learning focused on dyslexia or research-supported ways of teaching/supporting students who are struggling/striving readers. Professional development activities may include, but are not limited to, college courses, professional development sessions/seminars, conference attendance, professional books, and classroom materials.

## Application Instructions/Requirements:

- 1) Grant Application Cover Sheet.
- 2) Applicant vitae or resume
- 3) Detailed description of how the funds will be utilized
- 4) One letter of recommendation from a current supervisor/principal/professor
- 5) Digital photo of the applicant
- 6) Recipient will be expected to present what they learned and/or outcomes at the VSLA conference or a local chapter meeting or event within a year of receiving the grant.
