- **AP Exams**

[AP Exams](#) are from May 2-May 13. AP exams are given nationally with a specific window during which the exam administration must begin. **Students must be on time to their testing location.** Reporting times and testing locations will be listed in [Total Registration](#) and shared with students in late April, but as a general rule students will be expected to report to morning testing locations by 7:30 am with directions beginning at 7:40, and afternoon testing locations by 11:40 am with directions beginning at 11:45a. - **Attendance Procedures**

In addition to calling the BC attendance phone line (262-785-3994), families can also send an email to BCHSattendance@elmbrookschoools.org to report an absence to school. When reporting an absence, please provide the student's name and reason for the absence. If they are missing school due to illness, it will be important to let us know ALL of your child's symptoms and any physician confirmed diagnosis such as COVID-19. It will also be important to know if your child is staying home because they have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.

Being present and engaged in school are the first two keys for academic success. We will continue to monitor attendance and provide proactive communication regarding the attendance of all students. Additionally, we encourage students and parents to regularly monitor attendance records by logging into Infinite Campus for review.
