

TTLO 4.4 A2 Language Support Activity Plan

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Description: Learners will interact with an 11 minute 43 second enhanced screencast through [PlayPosit](#) featuring comprehensible input and activities dealing with professions. Learners will answer a series of questions about its content (multiple-choice, check-all-that-apply, and poll question types are used). The final questions contain formative assessment questions for the corresponding synchronous session to follow.

Context: Adult, post-secondary Spanish learners in the ACTFL novice range

Lesson Can-Do Statements Addressed: “I can identify some basic facts about common professions from memorized or familiar words and phrases when they are supported by gestures or visuals in informational texts / I can understand familiar questions and statements from simple sentences about common professions in informational texts.”

Communicative Mode: Interpretive listening with video

Delivery Mode: Asynchronous

Plan for Assessment: Each interaction is programmed to give immediate feedback. There are also formative assessments among the linguistically focused interactions that we will use in the following synchronous session. Class discussions would be assessed using a speaking rubric.

Material / Tech: Learners will need a device and the ability to use the [PlayPosit activity](#).

Estimated time for completion: 10 minutes or less, it must be completed before the corresponding synchronous session

Instructions:

1. Go to the [PlayPosit activity](#) (since we do not have a “class”, I could not “assign” it, so the link is the easiest way to access it).
2. Log in using your email or by clicking one of the social media / platform buttons that appear.
3. Click on the blue Begin button. Your progress won’t be saved – and that’s OK. Note: if the interactions don’t automatically come up, click the Settings Cog in the bottom-right corner and choose Learner. Instructor View doesn’t automatically stop for the interactions.

4. Answer the questions about the video that appear on the left side of the screen. The video will pause when you are answering a question. You will not be able to forward the video until you answer a question, but you can rewind the video to re-watch it. Watch as many times as you want.

5. Answer each question as best you can. There are lots of cognates and English glosses.

6. Get some questions wrong so you can see the feedback 😊
