Key Points for Trends Report

January 2024

- 1. The Action Nexus works to achieve seven key demands: 1) transforming systems for feminist economic and climate justice; 2) debt justice; 3) equitable and progressive taxation; 4) reforming the role of the Bretton Woods Institutions in global economic governance; 5) gender-just trade; 6) ending corporate capture; and 7) gender-just climate finance. This report looks at the gap between these key demands and the current global order.
- 2. Our new *Critical Trends* report illustrates the significant gap between the current global order and the feminist vision for economic and climate justice put forward by the Feminist Action Nexus and our allies. To begin to determine how far away we are from this vision—and therefore how to achieve it—the report examines recent developments, primarily since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020.

3. This report offers:

- a. A macroeconomic snapshot of key trends in the areas of our seven key demands, focusing on the period of COVID-19 onwards.
- b. A review of the **inadequate solutions for reform** (e.g. in sovereign debt restructuring and international tax abuse).
- c. A spotlight on **global advocacy proposals** from civil society and Global South countries to transform our economic system, and **local sites of struggle** against the consequences of this system.

4. This report does not provide:

- a. Deep **feminist structural analysis**, e.g. we do not examine the coloniality of debt or its specific gendered implications.
- b. **Recommendations** for action (beyond those highlighted in the global advocacy proposals).
