

Guide: Personal Housing

You have the option to have your own house in three locations:

- In the Guild Town of your Guild with the NPC **“Eden Innkeeper”**.
- In Aven with the NPC **“Aven Innkeeper”**.
- In Golden Plains with the NPC **“Golden City Innkeeper”**.

Note: If a person owns a house in Golden Plains, they can only enter at the Golden City Innkeeper. The same rule applies to Aven Innkeeper and Guild Towns Innkeeper, with the exception that any guild works.

Note 2: The rent is more expensive in Aven, slightly less in Golden Plains, and free in Guild Town.

House in Aven



Location: X: 321 Y: 308. Speak with the NPC **"Aven Innkeeper"** and choose the **“Manage or Visit Rooms in Aven”** option and **"Rent Room"** option and **“Confirm”**.

Note 1: The rent in Aven is 195 Gold per week at Level 130 character.

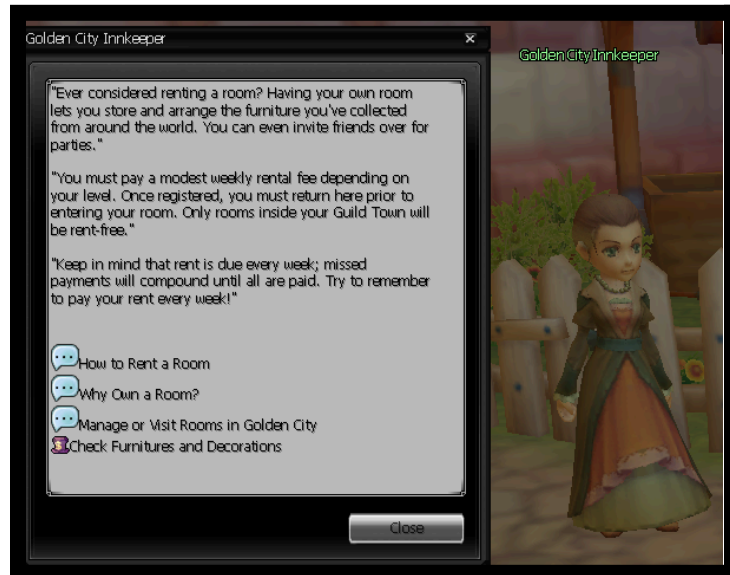


Note 2: if you add more space to the home storage, this rent will increase its fee for each additional expansion you purchase. The expansion fees are: 1500 Gold, 3500 Gold, 5500 Gold, 7500 Gold, 9000 Gold, and 10000 Gold.

Note 3: The rent must be paid every Monday. If not paid, you can do it later. However, the maximum limit is 10 weeks; exceeding this limit will result in losing your house along with all your furnishings.

House in Golden Plains

Alternatively, you can rent a house in Golden Plains at NPC **Golden City Innkeeper** X: 422 Y: 295. The rent cost is less than Aven.



House in Guild Town

The other option is to create a house in a Guild Town of your Guild. For this, the guild must be at least Level 3, and its guild town should be constructed.

The NPC Eden Innkeeper, coordinates **X: 116 Y: 126** (Eden Glen) and **X: 148 Y: 124** (Eden Peak) in charge is present in both villages (Eden Glen/Eden Peak), and the process is exactly the same as in Aven. The key difference is that it is entirely free in the Guild Town. However, if you leave the guild, the house will remain in Aven.



Where to get furniture

You can buy furniture in Aven at **X: 437 Y: 382** from NPC **“Wee Rowan”** - Other precious treasures using Honor Stars (arena currency, can also be earned through paths of destiny, Temple Arena, etc.).



Furniture can also be obtained by killing the pirate Roger, farming map chests, defeating elites, and buying them in the village.

Requirements for hosting a Banquet

- Comfort - Luxury - Rarity (Each Banquet requires different quantities).
- You need to have 3 players in the house to activate the banquet, and they must stay at least until the countdown reaches 2:00 minutes. If you leave before that, you won't receive the buff (the buff lasts for 2 hours).
- The number of decorations in the house can be increased by buying expansions up to 3 times.

Note: If the character hosts banquet regularly, they will receive special random banquet in the mail.

How to Host a Banquet

Banquets grant attributes to players, such as 5% ATK and M-ATK, etc.

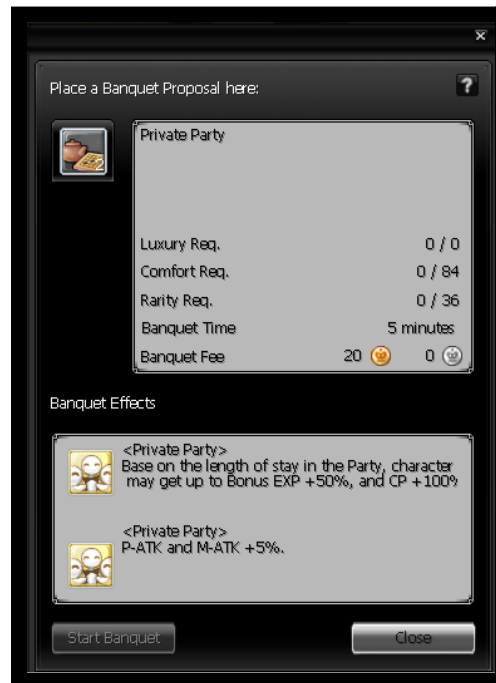


Before entering the house, you must have a Banquet in your inventory ready to be used if you decide to do so now. To do this, speak with any NPC **Innkeeper** and purchase one.



Note: Banquets have Rarity, Comfort and Luxury requirement for hosting them.

Once inside your house, talk to the Butler -> **"Host a Banquet"** -> Right Click to Banquet in your inventory -> **"Start Banquet"**.



The Chest allows you to do two things: place furniture inside the house or access Aven's portable bank, just like a Portable Bank would.
