Your son/daughter will soon be developing a schedule for his/her **JUNIOR** year. The courses your child selects, as well as the grades earned, will play a significant role in future accomplishments. It is important to set specific goals and pursue courses which allow your child to achieve those goals.

In order to make his/her education a rewarding experience, please assist your son/daughter in the completion of the attached course-offering sheet. For detailed course descriptions, please view the Program of Studies on the Guidance Website by going to www.lakeviewlocal.org, choosing Building→High School→Guidance Office→Program of Studies. We continuously update our Program of Studies to reflect changes in our course offerings. Please take into consideration that we have a seven (7) period day. All students are recommended to schedule one study hall period. Students are required to schedule six (6) classes per semester. **It is not recommended for juniors to take 5 CCP courses**, however, if your child chooses this, the student may have two study halls. This is the ONLY exception. Students are able to change their schedule during the first 5 days of a semester; however, this change depends on seat availability and potential scheduling conflicts.

NOTE to students taking College Credit Plus (CCP) courses: there are *additional* forms which must be signed and returned with your course offering sheet; they are attached to this packet. The open-campus / student lounge option for Lakeview's CCP courses will continue to be available in 2025-26.

Students who are considering taking CCP classes will complete their YSU application on February 6th, 2025 with Mrs. Schnurrenberger and representatives from the YSU CCP office. **If you miss YSU application day, it will be the student's responsibility to make arrangements to complete the application.**

To meet credit requirements for graduation, a student MUST earn a minimum of 21 credits meeting each course credit requirement:

1- Mathematics credits must include:

2- Science credits must include

one credit of Physical Science
one credit of Life Science or Biology
one credit of advanced study in one or more of the following:
Chemistry, Physics, Earth Science, Geology, Advanced Biology, Anatomy

3- All students must receive instruction in economics and financial literacy - students can gain this credit via Financial Literacy or Microeconomics (CCP).

4- Students must complete one credit of fine or performing arts.

5- Elective credits must include one or any combination of the following: foreign language, fine or performing arts, business, career-technical education, or any other courses not otherwise required in math, science, or social studies.
