Theme: “A GOD For All Seasons”, **Story Guide 3: Deuteronomy 34:1-9** (Fall: Trusting GOD In The Transition)

Open in Prayer, Welcome & Introductions

Review of Life Group Guidelines

Hook Question: What is your dream vacation destination? Why?

Background of the story: In chapter 33 of Deuteronomy, we find Moses blessing all of the tribes of Israel before his death. He calls out the name of each tribe and declares a blessing from GOD. Embedded in the blessings, Moses reminded the people how much GOD loved them and wanted to dwell among them and protect them from their enemies.

Tell the Story: This week’s Bible passage is found in **Deuteronomy 34:1-9**

Rebuild the Story

Read the Story out loud (look for additions or omissions)

Questions:

- Why do you think GOD personally buried Moses?
- How would you feel if you worked your whole life toward something but didn’t get to experience the final reward? Explain.
- How does it feel to trust GOD’S plan, even when it doesn’t match your expectations?
- How can you practice letting go and trusting GOD’S timing or outcome?
