

FORMAT AND GUIDELINES

TOURNAMENT EVENT RULES: CHSSA rules are linked above for Parliamentary Debate.

POWERMATCHING: Rounds will be powermatched beginning with Round 3.

PARTNER PREP ONLY: During prep time, a debater may communicate only with his/her partner.

EQUITY CONCERNS/PROTESTS: Please complete the forms at the Tabroom page for Equity & Protests.

CROSS-ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

All competitors who cross-enter in multiple events do so at their own risk. Competitors entered in multiple events are instructed to follow the following protocol:

- 1. **CHECK IN** to all rounds first.
- DO NOT wait to speak. Request to go early and speak out of the posted speaker position. **Debate cross entries prioritize debate! DO NOT LEAVE your debate round early for speech!**
- 3. Once you speak, leave for the next round. If cross-entered in Debate, speak in Speech round right away, then leave to go to Debate round. You <u>DO NOT</u> have to stay in the round if you are competing in another event.

4.	Judges are instructed to wait for all speakers in the round 90 minutes after the start
	time of the round, or 15 minutes after the last speaker has spoken (whichever comes
	first). Missing a round will result in being ranked last in the round.

EVENT BREAKS

We will attempt to have *most, if not all*, 3-2 teams advance to elimination round #1.

AWARDS

All speech finalists and debate quarterfinalists will be awarded awards on stage in the Center for Performing Arts. All competitors, judges, and supporters are welcome to attend.

All students who advance to Octofinals will receive an award available for pick-up in the Center for the Performing Arts lobby on Sunday starting at 3:00 PM.
