

2-Year College Checklist

- ☐ Decide on college major
 - Check school's specific requirements for your major/program
 - Nursing and health sciences often have earlier deadlines and stricter requirements
- ☐ Make sure you have a transportation plan to get to the college of your choice (license, etc.)
- ☐ Complete application online
 - Community college applications are generally school-specific and can be found on each school's website
- ☐ Complete transcript release forms (legal requirement for MHS to release your transcript)
 - Must be signed virtually by parent/guardian if you are under 18

- ☐ Complete Financial Aid Paperwork
 - ☐ FAFSA (Available December) - FREE <https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa>
- ☐ Resume - use to find a job while attending school
- ☐ OPTIONAL SAT/PSAT score reports sent to college from School Counselor (score could determine your placement in college level classes)-There are multiple measures that the Community Colleges are using to determine placement in college level English and Math-work with your school counselor for help on this
- ☐ After receiving acceptance from the college, make sure to turn in all other required materials (immunizations, proof of residency, proof of graduation, etc.) so that you can register for classes-keep checking your email and your college portal. Read everything sent to you from the school!
