Exam COVID-19 safety guidance following government Plan A announcement

On Wednesday 19 Jan, UK Prime Minister Boris Johnson <u>confirmed that most Plan B</u> measures introduced in December will expire on 26 January.

For the duration of the exam period (running until 28 January), our safety control measures for on-campus examinations will remain in place. Students must:

- continue to wear a face covering during in-person exams unless they have an exemption approved by Occupational Health or the Disability Advice and Support Service.
- continue to <u>take a Lateral Flow Test</u> within the 24-hour period before coming on-campus for an examination.

We are currently reviewing the new <u>Department for Education guidance</u> and discussing our COVID-secure measures with Manchester's Director of Public Health, David Regan. We will update you by the end of next week.
