Driving to School

Families who choose to drive their student(s) to school are asked to consider parking a block or two away from the school and walking the rest of the way. Please be considerate and careful when either driving through the loop and or when driving into the school parking lot. Do not block accessible parking spots, parked cars or block fire routes.

Do not park in the fire zone or bus loops for any reason.

Students who choose to drive to school are to be aware of the following student parking rules listed below:

- parking is very limited;
- park in designated areas and obey all municipal by-law signage;
- drive safely on school or adjacent property under the required speed limit of 15 km/h;
- respect the safety of Bill Crothers' students, staff, and visitors;
- no sitting in the vehicle with the sound system turned on loudly, no smoking/vaping in the vehicle, etc.;
- refrain from transporting other students without parental permission;
- ensure the number of passengers does not exceed the number of seatbelts in the vehicle; and
- comply with municipal by-laws and provincial traffic laws and practices e.g. seatbelts, idling.

Failure to follow these rules may result in the vehicle being towed or ticketed at the owners' expense and will result in loss of parking privileges at BCSS.
