PENNSYLVANIA

- <u>General guidance from PA Governor Tom Wolf</u>: "Even in a pandemic, grocery stores and food banks are life-sustaining and accessible; food production and distribution are continuing."

FUNDING RE: COVID-19

Service Providers, Non-Profits, Emergency Response

- <u>Pittsburgh Foundation Emergency Fund</u> (\$10million total) available to emergency service providers and nonprofit organizations serving on the front lines of recovery
- Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency Public Assistance Grant Reimbursements.
 PEMA Recovery invites any organization/person to <u>sign-up for the Public Assistance Grant reimbursement program</u> if you need to cover costs for 'emergency protective measures' for others (food, shelter, etc)
- 2020 CDBG Programs: City of Pittsburgh grants to support nonprofit and public service activities. Both <u>Public Service and Neighborhood Economic Development grants</u> are administered by the Community Development Division in the Office of Management and Budget.

For Small Businesses/Growers

- <u>Pennsylvania COVID-19 Working Capital Access (CWCA) Program, Pennsylvania Industrial</u>
 Development Authority Loans up to \$100,000 for small businesses including agricultural producers, to provide working capital for operations.
- American Farmer Trust Farmer Relief Fund. Information and eligibility guidelines linked HERE
- Food Animal Concerns Trust. Providing mini grants to livestock and poultry farmers experiencing hardship due to COVID-19. Apply here.
- The **James Beard Foundation** has created a Food and Beverage Industry Relief Fund to assist food and beverage businesses with less than 500 employees.
- SBA loans for small businesses
 - Economic Injury Disaster Loans (<u>EIDL</u>)
- Amazon Neighborhood Small Business Relief Fund To be eligible for a grant, recipients must have fewer than 50 employees or less than \$7 million in annual revenue.
- Payment-free, and interest-only periods via <u>Honeycomb Relief Loan Program</u> for small businesses impacted by COVID-19

- \$250k in funding Emergency Agriculture Assistance Grants to support farms, processors, and other small food businesses in Pennsylvania's food supply chain impacted by COVID-19 pandemic.
- Specialty Crops Producers are eligible for funding via USDA's Coronavirus Food Assistance Program (CFAP). Information from PA Dept. of Agriculture <u>HERE</u> and application <u>HERE</u>.

For Schools

- <u>Coronavirus Grant Request</u> offering emergency grants to support local school districts and nonprofit organizations in their efforts to ensure kids get the nutritious food they need
- If your child is normally able to obtain meals at school for free, your child will qualify for Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (*note, this is true even if your family does not individually qualify). More information <u>HERE</u>.

General Funds

- <u>loby</u> will double donations dollar-for-dollar on any crowdfund related to COVID-19
- COVID-19 Bridge Loans Program, Hebrew Free Loan Association. The Bridge Loan Program provides interest-free loans on a nonsectarian basis for up to \$5,000 to residents in the Pittsburgh area who are facing financial challenges caused by the coronavirus outbreak

Finding Free Food

- Food Assistance Locator from the Greater Pittsburgh Community Food Bank has increased free food distributions--FoodShare, and Grab & Go meals for kids.
 - The Food Bank also created a <u>resource page</u> that is updated frequently
- <u>412 Food Rescue</u> is working with retail, restaurant and nonprofit partners to distribute fresh food
- PA 211 is available statewide, and is focused on connecting people who are struggling to meet their basic needs.

 - Multiple meals will be distributed both days, parents can pick up food on behalf of students, and all children 18 and under are eligible.
