Course Description

The vocal jazz workshop is designed for the student who wishes to investigate the jazz style of singing. Emphasis is placed on stylistic authenticity, musical independence, and improvisation through the performance of advanced vocal jazz literature. All students must be enrolled in one of the music program's concert ensembles.

Required Materials

- Pencils

Course Objectives

- Increase understanding and appreciation of jazz music through listening and performance
- Learn and apply music theory and aural skills necessary to perform jazz repertoire
- Learn and apply unique vocal skills in jazz style
- Increase experience and comfort with jazz improvisation
- Perform vocal jazz arrangements of appropriate level both a cappella and with accompaniment

Rehearsal Procedures/Classroom Expectations

- Students will be in room 141 when the bell rings and moving to seats.
- Students will have all music, folder, and a pencil in every class.
- One person talks at a time. Extraneous noise is counterproductive to the rehearsal process.
- When not working directly with Mr. Molloy, students are working independently in small groups.
- Students may not leave the room without the expressed permission of Mr. Molloy.
- The rehearsal is a safe place. In a safe place, respect, kindness, consideration and forgiveness are the usual way of life. Everyone should feel safe to try something outside their comfort zone without fear of being laughed at.
- All cell phones are required to be in the caddie.
