#### Dear BC Community-

Over the past two weeks, BC students have taken over 1000 AP Exams! A big thank you to the teaching staff for preparing the students for the exams and also a big thank you to Ms. Lemke, Mrs. Premo and Ms. Ferschl for their tremendous work in organizing the many exams.

It never ceases to amaze me with the many things that our students do outside of the classroom. Two of our students: Chloe Lee and Ainsely Regner are working with students from other high schools and the Medical College of Wisconsin in studying to see if the COVID pandemic has influenced the interest of high school students in the field of healthcare. As part of their study, they are surveying high school students in the region. The <u>survey</u> titled "Effect of COVID-19 Pandemic on healthcare career choices among high school students" has been <u>approved by the Medical College of Wisconsin's Institutional Review Board</u> to be administered to high schools.

This study is relevant as it will help colleges understand the impact of the pandemic on enrollment in healthcare-related courses in the near future. The <u>voluntary and anonymous</u> survey (Survey Monkey Platform) will be emailed to the BC students on Monday, May 16th at 5pm. The <u>anonymous survey</u> consists of twelve questions and should take an average of two to three minutes to complete.





#### • Attendance Procedures

In addition to calling the BC attendance phone line (262-785-3994), families can also send an email to <a href="mailto:BCHSattendance@elmbrookschools.org">BCHSattendance@elmbrookschools.org</a> to report an absence to school. When reporting an absence, please provide the student's name and reason for the absence. If they are missing school due to illness, it will be important to let us know ALL of your child's symptoms and any physician confirmed diagnosis such as COVID-19. It will also be important to know if your child is staying home because they have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19.

Being present and engaged in school are the first two keys for academic success. We will continue to monitor attendance and provide proactive communication regarding the attendance of all students. Additionally, we encourage students and parents to regularly monitor attendance records by logging into Infinite Campus for review.

#### Chromebook
