Domain Specific vocabulary

Lesson / Instruction

 Write the following word on the board: expert. Ask the students what the word expert means. Elicit responses. Get students to understand that an expert knows a great deal of information about a specific topic. Begin writing a list on the board titled: Student Experts. Ask students to contribute to the list by sharing the name of a topic they know a lot about. Example: Josh – Football; Sienna – Baking; Kaleb – Video Games; etc. Discuss how these students are experts about these topics because they have experience and know much information about that field. Draw their attention back to the Informative Writing Helping Guide Page 3, and review the concept. Remind students that they are writing for information and will be drawing upon their own expertise as they develop their ideas. Direct Instruction: Explain to the students that part of composing their informative writing involves using very precise and specific vocabulary that relates to the topic they are devising. Use the Helping Guide to explain how to complete a Vocabulary Tree. Read through and discuss the sections on the Vocabulary Tree and reinforce the concept that this is another way students can show their expertise about their topic. DO NOT FILL IN THE VOCABULARY TREE YET. Guided Practice: Read through the passage "Your New Puppy" with the students. This is the same passage that they have seen before. Read through the passage a second time, but inform the students that instead of reading the passage for understanding, this time they are looking for specific vocabulary that supports the topic: Your New Puppy. Students will highlight or circle the domain-specific





vocabulary they find in the reading. Suggestion: Begin by having students work in teams to find the vocabulary words, but have them use pencil so that they can erase incorrect vocabulary if necessary. After giving some time to complete in teams, have students share with the class the domain-specific vocabulary they found and explain why they choose each word. Have students highlight or circle in crayon/colored pencil the correct answers as they share their answers and as students agree on them. Students may erase incorrect answers. Vocabulary Tree on Helping Guide: Go back to the Helping Guide and inform students that they will select specific vocabulary to accompany their Thinking Map & Paragraph Frame topic: Scooter Riding Safety Tips. Students may complete individually, collaboratively, or whole-class based on their current level of understanding and readiness.

Anticipatory Set: Ask students to think about the possibility of what it would be like to get a new student in your class. Ask them who would be the best people to help the new student adjust to their new surroundings (other than the teacher). Inform students that that since they have spent a great deal of time in 3rd or 4th grade that they are now experts about their grade.

Direct Instruction: Inform the students that they will be completing a Thinking Map to organize their ideas on the following topic: Tips and Advice for a New Student. Remind them to think about what has contributed to their success as a student and what the most important information needs to be understood (i.e. classroom rules, classroom procedures, playground rules, where the restrooms are, etc.) Independent Work: Students complete Independent Practice page.
