## Paragraph 4: Analysis and critique

- 1) Did you enjoy the book, or learn something new from it?
- 2) What did you enjoy about the book?
- 3) What did you not enjoy, or would change?

## Paragraph 5: Conclusion

- 1) Restate what the book was about and what happened in the end
- 2) Would you recommend the book to another reader? Why or why not?
- 3) Any final observations you have would go in this paragraph
