BEST OF TEXAS TENNIS 2025

Nominations and Voting

Individuals may nominate an eligible entity for the specified categories. Nominees may be nominated for multiple categories, so long as the nominee meets the criteria of each category.

There is no limit on the number of unique nominations an individual may submit, nor is there a limit on the number of nominations a nominee can receive. Multiple nominations for the same nominee will not result in additional votes for said nominee during the voting period of the campaign.

Anyone who lives in the geographic boundaries of USTA Texas, both USTA and non-USTA members, are eligible to nominate.

Voters are allowed to submit <u>one voting ballot form during the voting period</u>. Voters are required to provide an email address to ensure voting security. Anyone who lives in the geographic boundaries of USTA Texas, both USTA and non-USTA members, are eligible to vote. USTA Texas staff members are not eligible to vote.

Selections

Nominated individuals will be notified that they have been nominated for their "Best of Texas Tennis" category. When notified, a participation form will be provided to nominees, giving them the ability to 'opt out' of moving on to the voting round.

Additionally, in order for nominees to move to the voting round, they must be eligible for their respective category, remain in good standing with USTA Texas, and operate within its geographic boundaries.

Finalists and winners of each category will be chosen based on the number of votes received. Finalists and winners will be notified of their status. At this time, they will be sent a waiver to receive publicity around their Best of Texas Tennis recognition. If they do not choose to receive recognition, they may opt out, and the next highest vote-getter in the category, who is in good standing with USTA Texas, will take their place. USTA Texas reserves the right to rescind or disqualify any entries, nominees, finalists, or winners for any reason at any time.

Finalists and winners will be recognized through USTA Texas promotional efforts including, but not limited to, social media, email, web and print. No Instagram/Facebook/Twitter Endorsement.
