Fostering FAQ

How can I communicate with the Maria Meows Foster Community?

How does Discord work?

Discord is organized by text channels. We organize posts in the applicable channel. For example:

- Post your name, photo and intro in our # intros channel so we can get to know each other.
- Post photos, video and descriptions of your fosters in the # cat-intros channel. This
 is where we introduce our fosters and provide the photos, video and personality
 description necessary to promote them on Petfinder.
- Ask for supplies in the # fosters channel.
- Fenella (fenella@mariasmeows.org, 908-797-8081) would be happy to walk you through how to use Discord if you are unfamiliar.

What is my responsibility as a foster?

- You must provide good quality photos, videos and personality descriptions of your fosters in the Discord #cat-intros channel. This is essential for us to get them adopted.
- You must allow potential adopters to visit the foster in your home.
- You must play with your foster, socialize your foster, love on your foster and generally help your foster feel like part of your family.

• You must agree to keep your foster inside and to follow all of our <u>Foster Guidelines</u> (https://tinyurl.com/MMFosterGuidelines) at all times.

How long does fostering last?

Fostering usually lasts between one and four months, but the length of time a kitty is in foster will vary.

How much does fostering cost?

Nothing! Maria Meows provides all supplies, including food, litter and more. When you need something, post your need in the Discord **# fosters** channel or coordinate by phone or text with Maria Powers.

Are expenditures reimbursed?

Yes! But Maria must approve any and all expenditures prior to the money being spent for them to be reimbursed by the rescue. Please submit any approved expense receipts to fenella@mariasmeows.org for reimbursement.

How are vet visits handled?

Maria coordinates all vet visits and medications. Fosters cannot give medication or take kitties to the vet without Maria's direction.

What do I do in a medical emergency or if I have any issues?

- If you think there is anything medically wrong with your kitty or you need support for any reason, contact Maria ASAP for assistance.
- Only in a life threatening emergency should you consider bringing a kitty to the vet without Maria's direction. Details and vet contact information is in our <u>Foster</u> <u>Guidelines</u> (<u>https://tinyurl.com/MMFosterGuidelines</u>)

What if I notice behavioral issues?

Contact Maria ASAP for assistance.

What if I want to adopt my foster or my friend or family member want to adopt them?

All adopters must fill out our <u>adoption form</u>, pay the <u>adoption fee</u>, go through the interview process, be approved and sign an adoption contract to adopt.
