

## How to Add Option B Courses to UC/CSU Application

- 1.) On your college application, select the site high school you attend (LAHS or MVHS).
- 2.) For the grade level that you participated in Option B, go to step 3. For all other grade levels you attended LAHS or MVHS not as option B, enter in your courses by selecting from the drop down menu (UC Application) or from the auto-populated list (CSU Application).
- 3.) You will need to type in the current classes you are in. [Use this list of Option B class codes](#), to know how to correctly naming your classes (use the class name that is under the column “TITLE” (also highlighted yellow)). Email Teri Faught for questions.
- 4.) For the UC application, in the Academic History section, go to the “Additional Comments” box. Copy and paste the statement below to briefly explain Option B.

This year I am in an optional program that my school created specifically to support students during the Covid-19 pandemic. The program is called ‘Distance Learning Option B’. The program’s purpose is to provide high-quality, rigorous, education to students who need to stay in remote learning during a health vulnerable time. The program is run by an MVLA district administrator with MVLA teachers working weekly with students. My classes are through the education platform Edgenuity and UC Scout, taught by their California credentialed teachers. I appreciate having this option so that my family and I can stay safe during this unprecedented time.
