- Daily antigen testing clarification: (as interpreted by commissioner) you have multiple choices for indoor sports.
 Choice 1, is you can currently go into the gym for workouts and conditioning with masks and 6 feet apart (not practice). Choice 2, if there is practice, then there needs to be a baseline test. You can do periodic testing or daily antigen testing. Unclear of what is meant by periodic. If a student or coach tests positive, then you need to do PCR. In practice, testing is once a week and if competition, needs to be more frequent. Results need to be available within 48 hours before competitions.
- 2. Masks: in practice (after testing) masks are not mandated but CDHP has written that masks should be worn as much as possible.
- 3. Cohorts: not mandated but recommended that students stay within one cohort.
- 4. High contact sports (outdoor): authorized if under 14/100,00. If under 7, you don't have to test but have to do informed consent.
- 5. Transportation: CDHP has guidelines on it.
- 6. Competition outside of counties: within county or one adjacent county. You must follow the guidelines of the county which is the most restrictive.
- 7. If counties get into yellow, you will not need to adhere to restrictions around testing because you will be in the colored tier needed to play sports
- 8. Taking the indoor sports outdoors: A little unclear but moving sports outdoors will not require testing (ex. outdoor basketball practice). It is not recommended to play games outside.
