## THE SECOND PUNIC WAR

- FOUNDED BY THE PHOENICIANS IN 800 B.C.
- RULED A GREAT TRADING EMPIRE IN N. AFRICA AND S. EUROPE
- WOULD EVENTUALLY BECOME A THREAT TO ROME
- CARTHAGE HAD SOME COLONIES
  IN SICILY (ROMAN TERRITORY)
- ROME SENDS AN ARMY TO REMOVE THEM
- ROME BUILDS A NAVY (FOR THE FIRST TIME)
- WAR LASTS FROM 264 B.C. TO 24) B.C. YEARS UNTIL ROME FINALLY REMOVES CARTHAGE COLONIES FROM SICILY, AND MAKES THEM PAY A HUGE SUM OF MONEY
- CARTHAGE EXPANDED INTO SPAIN
- ROME IS UNHAPPY THAT THE
  CARTHAGINIANS ARE SO CLOSE TO
  ITALY
- ROME HELPS THE SPANISH TO REBEL AGAINST CARTHAGE
- CARTHAGE SENDS THEIR BEST GENERAL, <u>HANNIBAL</u>, TO ATTACK ROME IN 218 B.C.
- 46,000 MEN AND 37 ELEPHANTS

	- AT ZAMA, SCIPIO DEFEATED
