Why:

To increase student achievement of Benton Community students to prepare them for work and life beyond school.

Current State:

Benton Community uses a variety of assessments to make instructional decisions. We prioritize time for teams to collaborate around student achievement data in data teams at all levels. All teams at Benton have implemented the research-based data review process.

Suggested Process:

- A. Build capacity in the understanding of the steps of the data teams process
- B. Monitor the implementation of the process across grade levels
- C. Provide individualized support to teams based on their specific needs
- D. Analyze data retrieved from state and district assessments to monitor system
- E. Focus on Iowa Core Standards when working through the process
- F. Use short-cycle data to identify next steps in instruction using the data review process
