

eDCSD Online Summer Intensive

Please read this document all the way through before completing enrollment

What is eDCSD Online Summer Intensive Semester?

- Our summer school is called "Summer Intensive Semester" because each session is an entire 18-week/90-hour semester course condensed into 3 weeks.
- Students should expect to spend an average of 5-6 hours a day, 5 days a week. Each day of work is equivalent to one week of class instruction.
- You must receive a passing grade (60% or higher) in the class in order to receive a .5 semester credit.
- All coursework is completed strictly online. There is no in-class time or face-to-face sessions
 unless your student attends scheduled virtual help sessions or sets up a virtual session with
 their teacher.

Summer Session Dates:

eDCSD offers 2 separate sessions of the summer intensive courses:

- Session 1: Covers Semester 1 Course Work and runs June 2st 2025 June 23rd 2025
- Session 2: Covers Semester 2 Course Work and runs July 7th 2025 July 28th 2025

Enrollment:

Registration/Enrollment for both sessions will open Monday, February 24th, 2025.

- Session 1 enrollment ends Wednesday, May 28th, 2025 at 12 PM
- Session 2 enrollment ends Monday, June 30th, 2025 at 12 PM
- The cost for Summer Intensive is \$300 per session/per course for the DCSD high school students this year.
- Can be used as Grade Replacement: If you plan to take a course with eDCSD for Grade Replacement, you must contact your student's counselor at your current school to confirm acceptance for any grade replacement request and submit a grade replacement form to your current school prior to enrolling. eDCSD does not process grade replacements on transcripts.

Due Dates:

- All Course work is due by 11:59 PM on the last day of the session, no exceptions.
- Courses, once closed, will not be re-opened and your student will not be allowed to submit any late work. Teachers email students throughout each session when a student is falling behind to remind them of work due.
- Session 1 Work Due Date: June 23, 2025 11:59 PM

Session 2 Work Due Date: July 28, 2025 11:59 PM

Course Selection:

- You must register your student for each session in order for your student to take the full year of any course. Registration in only 1 session will result in your student only completing 1 semester of that course.
- Registration is **strictly limited to only one** course per student per session.
- eDCSD Online does not check to confirm you have enrolled your student in the correct course needed. Please verify this with your current school.
- Failure to notify eDCSD Online of your desire to drop a course or that you are unable to access your course past the 3-day drop deadline will result in a drop/fail for that course.

Accessing Your Courses:

- Many families travel over the summer. Unfortunately, we can not guarantee access to Canvas
 materials if students are outside of the continental United States. The DCSD IT Support center
 is not able to provide assistance for access to Canvas when outside of the US.
- We recommend that students only sign up for courses if they know they will have access to Canvas materials for the entire session.

Log-in credentials, orientation, and class start information is emailed out the 2 days before
each session begins. Please take time to view the orientation video as it contains vital
information. Session one information will be sent out on Friday, May 30, 2025, and Session 2
information will be sent out Wednesday, July 2, 2025.

Grades/Grade Replacement:

- All courses completed with eDCSD Online Summer Intensive will be posted to your student's DCSD Transcript.
- All Summer School Grades will appear under the Summer School Heading/Section on your student's transcripts.
- Most courses are NCAA eligible. *Please see our course guide at <u>www.edcsd.dcsdk12.org</u> for course-specific info*
- If you are needing Grade Replacement for any course you previously failed or in which you
 received a low grade during the regular school year, you must contact your counselor at your
 current school to confirm their acceptance of any grade replacement prior to enrollment in
 that course.
