



Who can borrow the board games?

Only Monroe and Jamesburg library card holders can borrow board games - they will not be put into transit for pickup at other libraries.

How many games can I borrow at a time?

You may borrow two games at a time.

How long can I keep the game?

For a month at a time. Games cannot be renewed.

Are there late fees?

One dollar per day, with a cap of ten dollars. Games may not be removed from your account for 24 hours after returning, so that staff have time to check for pieces. You will **not** be charged a late fee if this occurs.

What if I lose a piece?

Let us know when you return the game if there are pieces missing so that we can make sure the game is complete for the next patron. We will also check for all pieces before the game is discharged from your account.

If missing pieces will prevent a game from being playable, a flat fee of \$2.00 per piece will be charged. Games returned damaged, or not at all, may result in replacement fees and/or restricted borrowing.

What do I do if my game is missing pieces when I pick it up?

Let the librarian know if you discover missing pieces as soon as possible. Sometimes games are loaned out without all factory original pieces if the game is playable as is.
