Grant-In-Aid Requirements

Recipient Requirements

1. Applicant has chosen to pursue a career in education to receive the HFR scholarship. For the Rueppel Scholarship, a Green Bay West High student must be a female with preference given to those pursuing a career in education, nursing, a medical technician, a paramedic, missionary work..
2. Applicant has a financial need for assistance.
3. Applicant has a 3.0GPA or above and has potential to be successful in post-secondary education.
4. Applicant demonstrates leadership ability and involvement in extracurricular activities and/or civic, religious or community service.
5. Applicant has completed an essay of 200-500 words.
6. Applicant has included 2 letters of recommendations which include the applicant's skills, achievements, and educational goals. One must be from an educator at the applicant's high school. Both may be from high school personnel or one may be from a non-related adult who is familiar with the applicant's skills, achievements and educational goals.
7. The **postmarked application** is signed, dated and returned (via U.S. mail) by **March 15**.

Scholarship are awarded using the following criteria:

Financial need	25 points
Academic Achievement, including GPA & ACT	25 points
Leadership abilities, extracurricular activities, civic, religious and/or community service	15 points
Required essay	15 points
2 letters of recommendation	20 points

 - ☐ **On a separate sheet, your 200-500 word essay**
 - ☐ **Two letters of recommendations** which include the applicant's skills, achievements, and educational goals. One must be from an educator at the applicant's high school. Both may be from high school personnel, or one may be from a non-related adult who is familiar with the applicant's skills, achievements, and educational goals.
2. The recipient must be continuing studies in the education field. For West High, the student must be continuing studies in education, nursing, a medical technician, a paramedic, missionary work, or the medical field.
3. A competitive scholarship will be given for use towards tuition, fees, or campus room and board. The check will be mailed directly to the financial office at your institution.
4. If awarded, the recipient will be notified in early April. A recognition dinner will be in early May to honor the scholarship recipient. Due to the pandemic, recipients may be honored via an alternative recognition.

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Grant-In-Aid Reference Instructions

Dear Scholarship Applicant Reference:

Delta Kappa Gamma is a women's educational organization that is offering a \$1000 scholarship to a senior student who intends to attend post-secondary education to pursue a career in the field of education. We appreciate the influence you have had in this student's life and the time it takes to write this reference letter. Below is a list of criteria for the letter of recommendation. Also, please include the student's name, as well as the college s/he plans to attend and his/her major. Return the letter or recommendation to the student in a sealed envelope, so it can be mailed with the application which is due on March 15 of this year.

Your recommendation letter should include:

- The student's name, college attending, and major pursuing
- How long you have known the student and in what capacity
- What most impresses you about this student
- Why you feel the indicated career choice is a good fit for this student
- Describe the degree that the student has been involved in career planning and has developed goals that are achievable
- Anything else you know about this student that you feel we should consider that will influence the awarding of this scholarship
