{{Cartel Publishes A Chilling Video That Goes Viral}}

This horrifying post has been gaining attention on social media. One cartel publishes a chilling video that goes viral.

On June 21, 2022, <u>Héctor de Mauleón</u>, a renowned Mexican writer and deputy director of Nexos magazine, shared a startling <u>video</u> on Twitter. This 53-second clip revealed the presence of the Jalisco New Generation Cartel, commonly known as the C-J-N-G, in full force.

To sum it up, this <u>user</u> said: "What impunity, thanks to this 4th Government... it is not in vain that in this six-year term, the number of violent deaths of past Governments has already been exceeded, and respect for the army and G.N has been lost."

As the video gained viral traction, concern mounted among <u>users</u> regarding the safety of the individuals within the location, believed to be <u>El Volantin</u> in Jalisco. One user speculated that the C-J-N-G may have backing from the Lopez government, raising questions about the reasons behind their actions and their significance.

The primary question on everyone's mind is: What motivates them to act in such a public manner, and what are their ultimate goals? From a military perspective, this can be seen as a blatant display of force meant to intimidate potential adversaries by showcasing their capabilities.

Overall, the C-J-N-G is implementing this demonstration for their own benefit. It was revealed that their intention was to displace the Los Pájaros de la Sierra cartel from that region. The Los Pájaros Sierra cartel was originally a faction of the C-J-N-G under the leadership of Ernesto Mascorro Martinez, also known as El Chaparro.
