

1) Signup requirements

- Entrants must have a valid Reddit or Discord account.
- Entrants must have a means with which to play online (Generally Tabletop Simulator, but if you would like to use webcam and physical cards, or OCTGN, that's fine too. Make sure you and your opponent can both understand each others cards and board state)
- Entrants must be willing to have fun!
- To sign up, make a post indicating you wish to sign up in the reddit thread, or ping me on Discord.

2) Deckbuilding Rules

Life, the Universe, and Everything but the kitchen sink!

- Once the signup period ends, you will be given a random Mane; your deck must use that mane (taken from Silver Spanner I)
- Your draw deck and problem deck may contain no more than 1 copy of any card (taken from Silver Spanner III)
- Your draw deck and problem deck must contain exactly 6 cards each of the 15 sets that have been released. Meaning: 6 cards from each of
 - Premier
 - Canterlot Nights
 - Crystal Games
 - Absolute Discord
 - Equestrian Odysseys
 - High Magic
 - Marks in Time
 - Defenders of Equestria
 - Sequestria & Beyond
 - Friends Forever
 - Leaders & Legends
 - New Dawn
 - Fond Memories
 - New Generation
 - Tales of Light
- This will result in 90 cards between your draw deck and problem deck. The problem deck must be exactly 10 cards, so the draw deck must be at least 80. You may include more than 80 cards in your draw deck, but additional cards must come from supplementary sets, which include Rock 'n' Rave, Celestial Solstice, Prize Wheel, and other Promotional cards. (modified from Silver Spanner XXXI, and with a bit of Silver Spanner XXII as well)
- Twilight Sparkle, There's A Spell For That is banned
- Decks must be Harmony Legal
- Sideboarding is allowed. Your sideboard may be no more than 5 cards, and your deck must remain Harmony Legal after sideboarding. The rest of the constraints apply to the deck *with* the sideboard.

3) Tournament Rules

- You cannot change decks between players (honor system).
- After signups, players may begin working on their deck immediately and have until the start of their match to finish (meaning if their deck is not finished when round 1 pairings are up, they can still work on their deck until their match start time)
- Round one will start on Monday, November 10th.
- Players will have 1 week to complete each round's match and report the results in the Reddit Thread
 - It is up to the players to communicate with and arrange a time for their match.
 - If a match is not reported in that time frame, a draw will be issued out to both players.
 - There will be no extensions.
- The number of rounds will depend on the number of players, but it is expected to be 3.
- There is no tangible prize, however the winner will have their name added to a hall of fame to be showcased in all future Silver Spanner tournaments' results threads.
