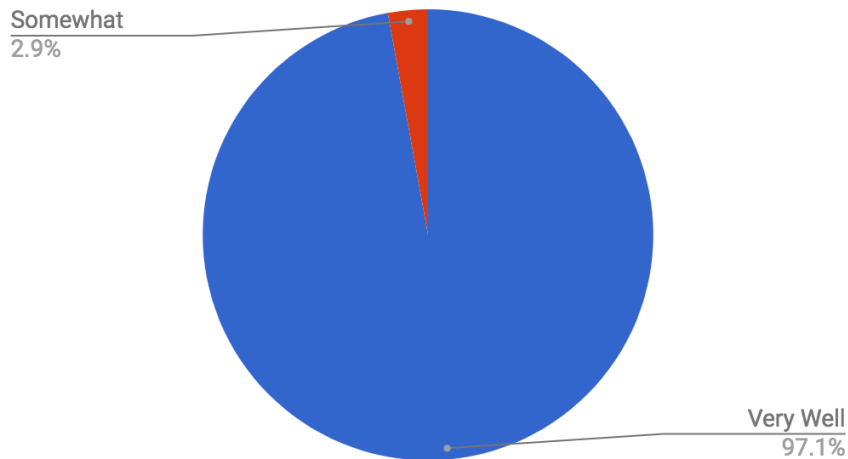


Mid Year Parent Survey 2017

The survey was completed after student conferencing. Many parents chose not to do the survey. The reason those parents gave was they were happy and didn't need to provide any feedback.

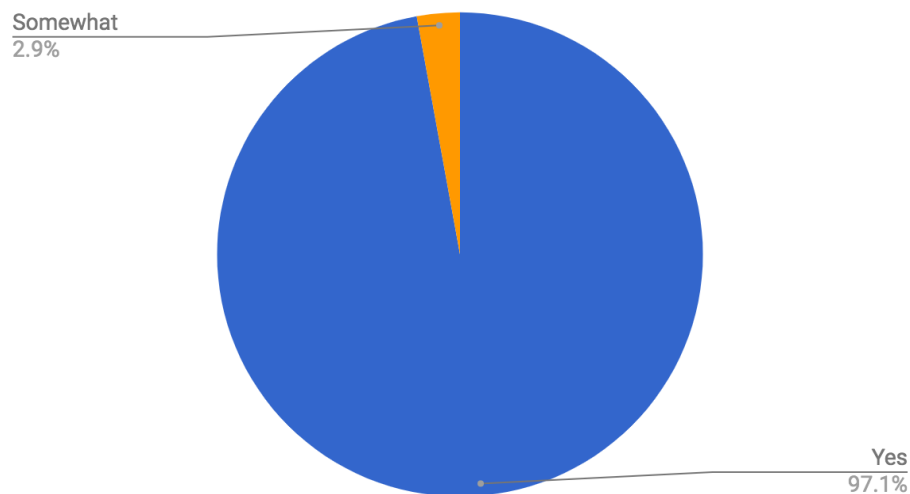
The survey was about reporting and communications with a comments area for open feedback.

How well does teacher know child?



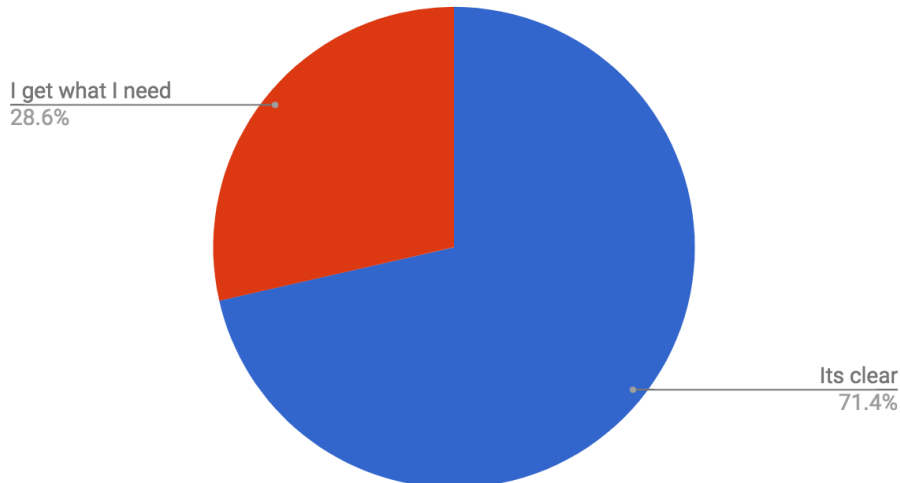
There was an option for "not very well" but no-one chose it

Did you feel you had the opportunity to add your expert knowledge as parent?



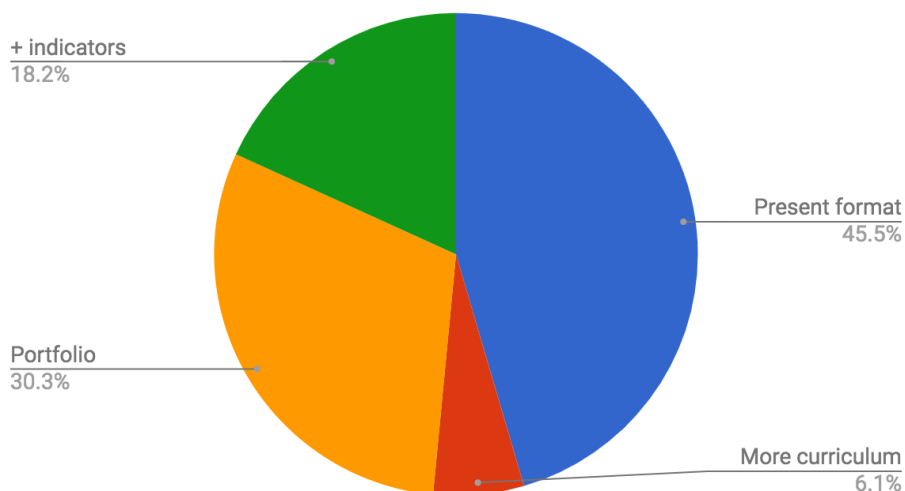
There was an option for "no" but no-one chose it.
