New Respiratory Illness Guidelines

Our new guidelines are as follows: individuals who test positive for COVID no longer need to isolate for five days. One should stay at home when sick but return to school or work once symptoms have improved and they have been without a fever for 24 hours. This now matches health advice for COVID, flu, and other respiratory illnesses.

The CDC website, <u>Preventing the Spread of Respiratory Viruses When You're Sick</u>, provides examples of when one is considered sick and suggests additional precautions. These recommended precautions are for 5 days following illness and include "steps for cleaner air, hygiene, masks, physical distancing, and/or testing when you will be around other people indoors." Please note that the guidance states these are suggested precautions, not requirements.
