Here are the highlights from the regular meeting on Wednesday, November 10th

- Samantha Williams was nominated to replace Mary Hansen as Board Clerk
- Heath Jackson reported on <u>school capacities and</u> <u>enrollment</u>.
- Jason Lords reported on our <u>literacy intervention plan</u> and fall IRI results.
- Guy Wangsgard introduced Deana Graham as the new executive director of the Bonneville Education Foundation.
- The Board approved the name of a future football and soccer stadium at Hillcrest based on a major donation from a local credit union.
- The Board approved a proposed map for adjustments to Trustee zones based on population shifts from the 2020 census.
- The Board approved minor changes to our COVID response plan, most importantly, the change in the High Risk for face coverings from "required" to "expected."
