Dear Students,


MMSD high school students have the opportunity to earn **elective high school credit** through work or volunteer experiences. The number of credits earned is based on the number of documented work/volunteer hours [1/2 credit for every 45 hours worked during COVID] while completing school requirements.

Step 1: Set up a time to meet with your counselor or school-based experiential learning coordinator. If you are in need of elective credits, determine the number of credits that you would like to earn through Work Based Learning with your counselor.



Step 3: Get a job if you don't already have one. Students must have a completed & signed <u>FTA</u> submitted before enrolling in the program.

Talk to your parent(s)/guardian, complete this ETA document either electronically or on paper. Email the completed ETA to your school-based coordinator.
