UHA EXECUTIVE POSITION DESCRIPTION

Role:	Executive Director	
Reports to:	The Board (State Reps) and AUF	

The Executive Director (ED) is the principal leader and has overall responsibility for the organisation's administration. The ED sets the overall annual committee 'agenda' (consistent with the views of members), help the committee prioritise its goals and then try to keep the committee on track by working within that overall framework. The executive committee members should have a sense of what they are trying to achieve throughout the year rather than just 'muddling through' from one committee meeting to the next. At the operational level, the major function of the ED is to facilitate effective management of committee meetings.

	 Lead the Executive Committee in preparation and presentation of the strategic 2 and 5 year plans.
