Classroom Policies and Rules

Grading Policy

Grades will be based on tests, class work packets, projects, and homework. The approximate value of each of these components in the outcome of the semester grade is as follows:

40% - Formative Assessments

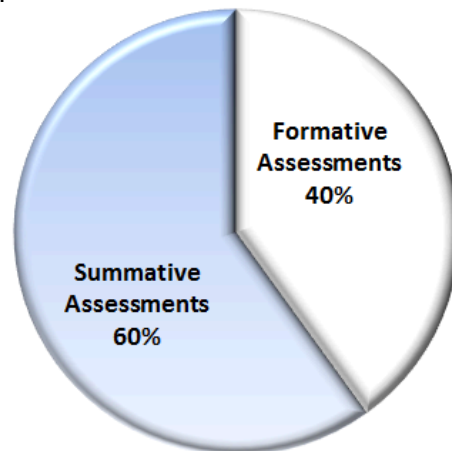
Includes:

- Class Work (Unit Packets)
- Ticket Out the Doors/Ticket In the Doors
- Warm-ups
- etc

60% - Summative Assessments

Includes:

- Unit Exams/Tests
- Essays
- Projects
- etc



Grades will be based on points. The grading scale is as follows:

4.1-5.0 = A

1.10-2.0 = D

3.1-4.0 = B

0-1.0 = F

2.1-3.0 = C

Class Work & Homework

Class work and homework packets will be collected at the end of each unit. If you are having trouble completing class work and homework because there is something you do not understand ASK FOR HELP!

Late Work:

Homework should be turned in on the day it is due. Late work will be reduced by 10% for each day it is late.

Excessive late assignments are cause for a phone conference with your parents/guardians.

Make-up Policy

Make-ups are permitted for tests, quizzes, homework, etc. following an **excused absence**.

It is **YOUR responsibility** to make up assignments that were missed. Take the time to talk to me and make arrangements as soon as you come back. Test retakes will be held during lunch, or after school.

Daily Procedures and Behavioral Objectives

To assure a proper learning environment in the classroom, these rules will be followed:

1. Be in your assigned seat ready to work when the tardy bell rings.
2. Bring all the necessary materials/supplies to class.
3. All assignments must be headed with your name, date, period, and class.
4. Food and drinks are not allowed in class. Bottled water is the only exception.
5. **Cell phones must be placed in the cellphone pouch before class starts**
6. **Cell phones and headphones of any kind are not allowed to operate during class!** If this rule is violated, the cell phone and/or headphone will be confiscated.

7. **Treat everyone with the same respect you wish to be given.** Practice tolerance and respect for other opinions and points of view.
8. Always be polite. This includes **no talking while the teacher is instructing.**
Raise your hand when participating in class discussion or if you have any questions.
9. The bell does not dismiss the class. Only Mr. Garcia can dismiss the class.
10. Plagiarism and cheating is never tolerated.
11. **Stay in your seat unless you raise your hand.** Do not get up without raising your hand.
12. Do your best! The more you put into this class, the more you will get out of it.

Discipline Policy

If **you** choose not to follow the rules, expectations or behave inappropriately in class...

On the first offense you will be given a **verbal warning**. If the behavior continues you will be given a **formal warning**. If the behavior continues after the formal warning your **parents will be contacted**, you may receive **lunch detention**, a **parent/teacher meeting**, a **school referral**, or be **sent to the office**.

Mr. Garcia will evaluate each situation on a case by case basis. For more serious offenses students may receive a school referral and or be sent to the office without a verbal warning.
