

PD Needs 2022 - Teacher Survey Summary of Responses and Comments


ALL: What is your preference on timing of sessions? 721 responses








ALL: Which of the following areas are you MOST interested in receiving PD on this summer through Arch Ford? Check all that apply.




ELEMENTARY LITERACY: What specific needs do you have in the area of elementary (K-5) literacy? Check all that apply.



SECONDARY LITERACY: What specific needs do you have in the area of secondary (6-12) literacy? Check all that apply.




MATH: What specific needs do you have in the area of math? Check all that apply. 355 responses




ELEMENTARY SCIENCE: What specific needs do you have in the area of elementary (K-5) science? Check all that apply.




SECONDARY SCIENCE: What specific needs do you have in the area of secondary (6-12) science? Check all that apply.




ALL: What specific needs do you have in the area of family and student engagement? Check all that apply.





ALL: What specific needs do you have in the area of social and emotional learning (SEL)? Check all that apply.




ALL: What specific needs do you have in the area of trauma? Check all that apply. 498 responses





I only have them 45 mins one day a week at the end of their day. We're packed in a small room and it's a nightmare. I would also love hands on art sessions where I learn new techniques...especially with clay.
