The signatories,

Acknowledging the conflict with israel and palestine,

Recognizing the importance of this discussion,

Emphasizing that the signing countries commit to apply any of the following clauses,

Acknowledging the urgency of the discussed problems,

Bearing in mind that all the proposed clauses will be achieved and implemented in the near future.

Welcoming any country that is ready to show a strict willingness to solve the discussed problem,

- 1. **Emphasizes** helping Palestine to:
 - a. Be recognized as an independent state by:
 - i. Raising awareness for their troubles by;

- 1. Making a movement of public diplomacy to explain to outsiders and other countries the current situation, asking for help and recognition
- 2. Making a social media channel, which his role is to expose the truth to the large crowds on the internet
- ii. Helping them financially, funding them using the large financial pool of the wealthier countries such as japan, US, bahrain, Oman and more;
- iii. Removing the terror organizations and replacing them with a state army.
- b. attain the means to survive independently by:
 - i. Funding them with solar panels, wind turbines, and other means of renewable energy and fuel from countries that this is their expertise;
 - ii. Stopping the war, rescuing all hostages.
 - iii. Allowing and encouraging farmers from other countries to go help Palestine's agricultural grounds;
 - iv. Improving infrastructure and funding some renovations
 - v. Improving their international market by:
 - 1. establishing trade lines with other countries;
 - 2. Making their own currency or way for international market recognition
- 2. **Demands** to settle the conflict with Israel by:
 - i. Implementing educational plans to:
 - 1. Teach the younger generation to live peacefully and not hate others for either geographic location or religion.

- 2. Making the younger generation more capable of diplomatic talking and rational thinking
- ii. Implementing a two state solution of Israel and Palestine that would Allow Palestine to create an independent country whilst respecting Israel and negotiating with it.
- 3. **Encourages** the reeducation of Israeli and Palestinian children by the UN-guided staff
 - a. Through a new special education team using the UN's fund for their salary.
 - b. By Forming an internet web for the education of all children around the land so that they can learn from home
- **4.** <u>Invites</u> Palestinians who were hurt from the conflict financially to come to Oman and:
 - a. Receive residency while their property gets rebuilt.
 - b. Receive a place to stay and humanitarian aid if they can't do so in the holy land.
