- b) Search for pictures on the internet (google images)
- c) Fold a DIN A-4 sheet into thirds as if it were a real leaflet
- d) Be creative and use any material you like to elaborate your leaflet!

DESCRIBING the CITY (See handouts with model texts)

- a) Include information about the following aspects: location and number of inhabitants, typical food, leisure time, cultural events and important dates, places to visit, etc.
- b) Remember the aim of your leaflet: To make the place attractive to potential visitors.
- c) Useful language:

Vocabulary: Adjectives (awe-inspiring, breathtaking, fascinating, sensational, marvellous, outstanding, superb, delightful, impressive, surprising, well-known, popular, so-called, famous, massive, huge, enormous, relaxing, entertaining, cosmopolitan)

Nouns (marvels, wonders, landmark, refuge, meeting point, spot, scenery, landscape)

Verb tenses: Imperative: Experience the best of the Australian landspace; don't miss your opportunity to discover mankind history at the British Museum)

Will+bare infinitive: You will enjoy awe-inspiring views as you leave Edinburgh
