MARINETTE — Kenneth P. Sweet, 64, of 824 McAllister Ave., Marinette, died unexpectedly Saturday evening, Feb. 8, 1992, at Bay Area Medical Center.

He was born Nov. 9, 1927, in Oshkosh, where he graduated from high school in 1946. He served in the Navy as an electronics technician during World War II and the Korean conflict. In 1954, he graduated from the University of Wisconsin-Madison with a degree in electrical engineering. He joined Wisconsin Public Service Corp. in 1954 as an industrial sales representative in Green Bay. He transferred to Oshkosh in 1957 and was named Chilton district manager in 1967. He became M&M division manager for WPS in 1978, a position he held until his retirement in 1990.

Active in area civic groups, he was a past president of the Marinette Area Chamber of Commerce, a member of the Chamber Voyageurs; was serving on the board of directors of the Marinette Area Economic Development Corp.; a member of the Menominee Chamber of

Commerce, Marinette Kiwanis Club, Marinette Elks Lodge, the Tri-County Safety Council and was a past president of the United Way.

Mr. Sweet was also a member of Holy Family Parish.

On Aug. 24, 1946, he married the former Dolores Nelson at St. Peter's Church in Oshkosh.

Surviving are his wife, Dolores; one son, Kenneth P. Sweet Jr. of Dallas, Texas; three daughters, Amy Jo Sweet of Milwaukee, Claire Sweet (David Ebacher) of Raleigh, N.C., and Stephanie (Tom) Marshman of Bolingbrook, Ill.; six grandchildren, JaNelle and Jennifer Merry, Lori Sweet, Paul Sweet, Kenneth Sweet III and Gina Sweet; and one brother Clifford Sweet of Oshkosh.

There will be no visitation.

Funeral services were conducted Monday, Feb. 10, in Holy Family Church, Taylor Street, the Rev. Larry Marto officiated.
