Will Hamas Listen To Trump?

President-elect Donald Trump let Hamas know he means business if the hostages aren't released by January 20th as we see in a report from *The Jerusalem Post*:

US President-elect Donald Trump said Hamas must release the hostages held in Gaza captivity "soon" when speaking to reporters at his Mar-a-Lago New Year's Eve gala.

Trump wasn't as colorful this time and didn't mention his previous deadline:

"Let me put it this way," he said, "they [Hamas] better let the hostages come back soon." He was pretty non-committal about a ceasefire as well:

When asked about a ceasefire, Trump said, "We're gonna see what happens."

As we know, Trump was more direct in previous comments:

Trump has made several similar statements since winning the US election in November, including a post on his Truth Social network earlier in December in which he promised severe repercussions if the hostages were not released by the date he assumes office.

"If the hostages are not released prior to January 20, 2025, the date that I proudly assume office as President of the United States, there will be ALL HELL TO PAY in the Middle East, and for those in charge who perpetrated these atrocities against humanity," his post read.

And we already knew about his strong ties with Prime Minister Netanyahu and Israel. One Israeli leader appreciates Trumps clear cut stances:

Trump's remarks earlier in December prompted comments from Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and multiple Israeli ministers.

"How refreshing it is to hear clear and morally sound statements that do not create a false equivalence or call for addressing 'both sides,' but rather clarify who are good and who are bad," Finance Minister Bezalel Smotrich stated at the time.

One hostage family member sees the incoming president as someone who can get them home: The Hostage Families Forum praised Trump for his message, and parents of hostage Omer Neutra expressed their belief to The Jerusalem Post that Trump could secure the release of the remaining hostages held in Gaza captivity.

"He's a deal maker. He's done it before," Ronen Neutra said.

So Hamas is on the clock. Iran knows exactly what Trump will do and they know that any mischief they have up their sleeves will need to be done now because once he is sworn in as Commander-and-chief he will not be shy about doing anything with them. All of their proxies are also on the clock as well so those Houthi rebels better simmer down or cease and desist. Trump has his eyes on them as well. Oh, and Happy New Year!
