**Meeting called to order at 6:35 p.m.**

1. Last forum:
  1. Discussion on resolution to cap governor's salary (UCLA cannot cap salaries directly). Gene Block comments.
  2. Discussion of elections.

  4. Resolution to change number of required signatures, not enough people run and most positions are uncontested.
  5. Westwood community council issue (different from community council), discussion of boycott over student representation. Chair of council came to the forum. Steven Sars disputed Michael Skiles' accusations.
  6. Executive session, discussion of lawsuits
2. Upcoming forum: continued discussion on Westwood neighborhood council decision. Do we support decision to boycott council?
3. Ph.D. panel for undergrads on Wednesday May 15. Sent link to sign up sheet. Need about 13 grad students, but more is better. Departmental diversity is generally low, want people from other departments to sign up. Food will be provided.
